# Qualifications, Requirements and Necessary Documentation



Texas Administrative Code Rule §402.420

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## **DEFINITIONS**

**By-laws** are a standing set of rules governing the regulation of an organization's internal affairs.

**A constitution** is the set of fundamental principles according to which an organization is governed.

**Articles of Incorporation** are documents that set forth the basic terms and purposes of an organization and are the official recognition by the Secretary of State.

A **Certificate of Formation** is a document filed with the Texas Secretary of State, to create a nonprofit corporation under the provisions of the Texas business Organization Code (BOC).

**Nonprofit organization** means an unincorporated association or a corporation that is incorporated or holds a certificate of authority under the Texas Non-Profit Corporation Act.

The following chart provides the terms used by the Texas Non-Profit Corporation Act and the terms used to describe the same filing instrument under the BOC.

## INTRODUCTION

# To qualify under the RELIGIOUS SOCIETY status (Bingo Enabling Act §2001.002 (26):

"Religious society" means a church, synagogue, or other organization organized primarily for religious purposes.

Your organization has decided it wants to conduct bingo to fund a charitable purpose, and needs to be licensed to legally operate.

Listed below are a few questions to consider before your organization begins the application process:

- 1. Is your organization a non-profit unincorporated association or corporation?
- 2. Is the conduct of bingo legal in the municipality, county, or justice precinct where your organization has its primary business office?

  If not, you may be able to play in an adjacent county where bingo is legal. Check the adjacent counties.
- 3. Has your organization been organized in the state of Texas for at least three years?
- 4. Does your organization have a bona fide membership list/roster?

If you answer "NO" to any of these questions, you are not currently qualified for a license to conduct charitable bingo.

If you answer "YES" to all of the questions, proceed with your application and utilize this guide to assist you in the process.

## A GUIDE FOR RELIGIOUS SOCIETIES

The applicant must be organized primarily for religious purposes. The name of the applicant organization must match the name of the organization on the organizing instruments.

#### What is needed:

A signed and dated copy of the most recent version of all of the organization's organizing instrument(s);

Or

A copy of the page from the applicant's parent organization religious directory that lists the applicant organization's information.



# Articles of Incorporation First Church of Someplace, Texas A Texas Nonprofit Corporation

**Article 1. Entity Name and Type.** The name of the entity is First Church of Someplace, Texas. It is hereinafter sometimes referred to as "the Church." The entity being formed is a nonprofit corporation.

Article 2. Organizer. The name and address of the Organizer is Paul Baptist, 100 Residence Road, Someplace, Texas
<b>Article 3. Registered Agent and Registered Office.</b> The initial registered agent is an individual resident of the state whose name is John Baptist. The business address of the registered agent and the registered office address is: 100 Church Street, Someplace, Texas

Article 5. Governance. The Church is organized and is operated under a

Article 4. Members. The Church shall be a nonprofit corporation which has

members.

congregational system, and the management of the affairs of the corporation is to be vested in the Church's members.

Article 6. Purpose. The Church is organized for religious purposes. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for service rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of its purpose. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Certificate, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

## **Articles of Incorporation (cont'd)**

**Article 7. Winding Up.** Upon the winding up of the corporation, after all liabilities and obligations are paid, satisfied, and discharged, the property of the corporation shall be applied and distributed as follows: (1) property held by the corporation on a condition requiring return, transfer, or conveyance because of the winding up or termination shall be returned, transferred, or conveyed in accordance with that requirement; and (2) the remaining property shall be distributed for one or more exempt purpose within the meaning of section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

**Article 8. Amendment.** An amendment to this Certificate of Formation must be submitted to a vote of the members in a regular or special meeting. Notice containing the proposed amendment or a summary of the changes to be effected by the amendment shall be given to the members within the time and in the manner provided by the Bylaws for giving notice of a meeting. The vote required for adoption of an amendment shall be at least two-thirds of the votes of members present at the meeting at which the action is submitted for a vote.

**Article 9. Effective Date.** This document becomes effective when the document is filed by the Secretary of State.

The undersigned signs this document subject to the penalties imposed by law for the submission of a materially false or fraudulent instrument.

## **Bylaws for First Church of Someplace, Texas**

These Bylaws constitute the rules adopted by First Church of Someplace, Texas, (hereinafter sometimes referred to as, "the Church") for the regulation and management of its affairs.

**Article 1. Purpose of the Church.** (Optional. Elaborate, if desired, on the religious purpose statement in the certificate of formation, but do not contradict, or provide for anything inconsistent with, the certificate of formation.) Example:

1.1. The Church exists to worship God, to proclaim the Word of God, and to be in service to God.

**Article 2. Doctrine of the Church.** (Optional. A doctrinal statement may be included in the bylaws at the option of the church.)

## **Article 3. Polity of the Church.** (Optional but legally desirable.) Example:

3.1. The Church is an autonomous body, governed by its congregation, subject solely to the Lordship of Jesus Christ.

## Article 4. Cooperation. (Optional but legally desirable.) Example:

4.1. The Church seeks to identify associations and conventions with which the Church may cooperate for the great objects of the Kingdom of God. In every instance, cooperation shall be voluntary on the part of the Church and no association or convention or any other body or person shall have any authority over the Church.

#### **Article 5. Ordinances.** (Optional) Example:

- 5.1. Baptism.
- 5.2. The Lord's Supper.

### **Article 6. Membership.** (This area is legally important.) Example:

- 6.1. The membership shall be composed of Baptized believers who have been accepted for membership by profession of faith in Jesus Christ as his or her Savior and Lord and as a candidate for baptism by immersion, or by promise of a letter from another church of like faith and order, or by statement that he or she is or was a member of a church of like faith and order and his or her records, for any reasonable cause, are no longer available.
- 6.2. Candidacy.
- 6.3. Acceptance by the Church.

## Bylaws for First Church of Someplace, Texas (cont'd)

- 6.4. Privileges of Membership. Each member shall be entitled to one vote on each matter submitted to a vote at a regular or special meeting of Church members.
- 6.5. Member's Right to Inspect Books and Records. A member, on written demand stating the purpose of the demand, is entitled to examine and copy at the member's expense, in person or by agent, accountant, or attorney, at any reasonable time and for a proper purpose, the books and records of the corporation relevant to that purpose.
- 6.6 Discipline.
- 6.7. Termination of Membership.

**Article 7. Watchcare.** (Optional. May be helpful to differentiate from membership.)

### **Article 8. Meetings.** (This area is legally important.) Example:

- 8.1. Act of the Membership. The membership may act only at a properly called meeting of the membership where a quorum is present.
- 8.2. Quorum. Members present at a meeting for which notice has been given shall constitute a quorum.
- 8.3. Voting. At such a meeting, a member may only vote in person. A vote of a majority of the members in attendance shall be an act of the membership, except that a two-thirds majority of the members in attendance shall be required for the Church to take the following actions: dissolution of the corporation, merger or consolidation with another corporation, sale of substantially all of the corporation's assets, amendment to the corporation's Certificate of Formation or of its Bylaws.
- 8.4. Regular Meetings. A regular meeting of members shall be held \_\_\_\_\_\_\_.
  8.5. Special Meetings. A special meeting of the members may be called by \_\_\_\_\_\_\_, or by members having not less than one-tenth of the votes entitled to be cast at the meeting.
  8.6. Notice. Notice of regular and special business meetings shall be given by oral announcement at a regularly scheduled worship service before the meeting, or by \_\_\_\_\_\_\_.
  8.7. Location. All meetings shall be held at \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ (for example, "the church.").

## Bylaws for First Church of Someplace, Texas (cont'd)

## **Article 9. Parliamentary Authority.** (Optional but desirable.) Example:

9.1 The rules contained in the then current edition of *Robert's Rules of Order* not inconsistent with the Certificate of Formation or the Bylaws, are adopted by the Church.

**Article 10. Officers.** (A church may have any officers it chooses. The Bylaws should identify the officers and their functions, provide for the manner of election of officers, and specify the term of office, not to exceed three years. Typical officers include Pastor, Moderator, Clerk and Assistant Clerk, and Treasurer.)

#### **Article 11. Committees.** (Optional but desirable.) Example:

- 11.1. Standing Committees.
- 11.2. Special Committees.
- 11.3. Task Forces and Ministry Teams.

#### **Article 12. Deacons.** (Optional but desirable.) Example:

- 12.1. Purpose and Function.
- 12.2. Qualifications.
- 12.3. Election.
- 12.4. Deacon Officers.

**Article 13. Amendment.** (Some rule should be declared. The Code allows total flexibility. Normally some "supermajority" is required to amend the bylaws.) Example:

13.1 These Bylaws may be amended at any regular meeting or at any special meeting, if the notice of the meeting contained notice of the proposed amendment, upon the adoption of the amendment by the vote of two-thirds of the members present.

## **ORGANIZED IN TEXAS FOR THREE YEARS**

The applicant must have been organized in Texas for at least three years. Additionally, the document submitted must reflect the applicant's name, Texas address and either be dated three years prior to the applicant date or establish the date the organization was founded.

#### What is needed:

If the applicant is affiliated with a state or national organization, **Verification by Parent for Charitable Organization Conductor FORMID 110**, can be completed. If the applicant is not affiliated with a state or national organization, a copy of a listing in a publication such as a national roster or newspaper article naming the organization;

Or

A letter to the applicant from a government agency.

## **Submit one of the following:**

Organization possesses a letter from a government agency.
Or
Verification by parent organization.
Or
Copy of a listing in a publication such as a national roster or newspaper article naming the organization.

## **DEMONSTRATION PROCESS**

The applicant must demonstrate significant progress toward the accomplishment of the organization's purposes during the twelve months preceding the date of application. All documents must be dated and indicate the name of the organization.

#### What is needed:

At least three (3) different types of acceptable documents as proof that organization was engaged in furthering its charitable purpose for the time period beginning one year prior to the date the application was signed.

## **Examples of acceptable documentation:**

- 1. A letter from the diocese
- 2. Notices of church services, and/or church bulletins
- 3. Canceled checks for clergy salaries, religious books, materials and/or supplies, maintenance of religious building(s)
- 4. Records of marriages performed, or records of funerals performed.

To establish the beginning date, an organization may submit documentation dated up to three months prior to the year before the application was signed in furthering its charitable purpose throughout the past twelve months.



Our records indicate that you were issued a determination letter in March 1946, that you are currently exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the internal Revenue Code, and are not a private foundation within the meaning of section 509(a) of the Code because you are described in sections 509(a)(1) and 170(b)(1)(A)(i).

With your request, you provided a copy of the Official Catholic Directory for 2010, which includes the names and addresses of the agencies and instrumentalities and the educational, charitable, and religious institutions operated by the Roman Cetholic educational, charitable, and mitiglaus institutions operated by the Roman Cetholic Church in the United States, its territories, and possessions that are subordinate organizations under your group tax exemption. Your request indicated that each subordinate organization is a non-profit organization, that no part of the not earnings thereof incres to the benefit of any individual, and that no substantial part of thair activities is for promotion of legislation. You have further represented that none of your subordinate organizations is a private foundation under section 509(a), although all subordinates do not all ahere the same sub-classification under section 509(b). Based on your representatione, the subordinate organizations in the Official Catholic Directory for 2010 are recognized as exempt under section 501(c)(3) of the Code under GEN 0028.

Donors may deduct contributions to you and your subordinate organizations as provided in section 170 of the Code. Bequests, isgacles, devises, transfers, or gifts to them or for their use are deductible for federal estate and gifts tax purposes if they meet the applicable provisions of section 2055, 2108, and 2522 of the Code.

Subordinate organizations under a group exemption do not receive individual exemption letters. Most subordinate organizations are not separately listed in Publication 78 or the EO Business Master File. Donors may varify that a subordinate organization is included

## ACCEPTABLE GROUP LETTER

Letters are from the IRS and must include:

- 1) Group's EIN
- 2) Group Exemption Number is listed.
- 3) Group's name and address.
- 4) The IRS considers your organization a 501(c)(3) organization.

Must provide a photocopy of the directory cover and the page with your organization highlighted.

## **ORGANIZATION'S MEMBERS AS OPERATORS**

The applicant may appoint only the organization's members to serve as operators.

#### What is needed:

A current membership list that includes officers and director noted. Officers would include a priest, pastor, rabbi, or other head of the church. Membership list will be compared to the persons listed on the application to confirm that only members have been named as operators.

## CRIMINAL HISTORY INVESTIGATION

The applicant must ensure that none of the organization's officers, directors and operators have been convicted in any jurisdiction of a gambling or gambling related offense; and, have not been convicted of a criminal fraud offense, with the exception of a criminal fraud offense that is a Class C misdemeanor.

The Commission will compare the number of officers and directors included in the documents to the application to ensure all officers and directors have been disclosed.

A criminal history check on all officers, directors and operators will occur.

Any officer, director, or operator listed on the application not meeting the criminal history background requirement must resign before a license may be issued.

#### What is needed:

A signed, dated copy of the most recent version of all of the applicant organization's organizing instrument(s) that list the officer and director positions;

Or

If officers and/or directors are not listed in organizing instruments, a current membership list identifying officers and directors.

If officer and/or director positions are unfilled, a statement signed by an officer indicating which positions are vacant.

### Submit one of the following:

☐ Copy of organizing instruments that list officers and directors.
Or
☐ Copy of current membership list noting all officers and directors.

## LICENSE APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS, SECTION 2001.102(a)(b)(c)

An applicant for a license to conduct bingo must file with the commission an application on a form prescribed by the commission. (*Application for an Original License to Conduct Bingo FORM ID 1*).

#### What is needed:

Most recent copy of IRS Form 990, if the organization is required to file it. Indicate on the application (FORMID 1, item 11), if the organization is not required to file IRS Form 990;

#### And

If the organization is organized under the law of this state, the organization must be in good standing with the Texas Secretary of State (SOS).

The Commission will request additional documentation from the applicant if unable to validate good standing directly with the SOS.

This documentation may include a copy of "Tax Clearance Letter for Reinstatement" from the State Comptroller of Public Accounts and a stamped, filed copy of an "Application for Reinstatement" from the Secretary of State.

## **Submit the following:**

IRS Form 990 or indication on the application that organization is not
required to file Form 990. (FORMID 1, Item 11).
Proof that the applicant is in good standing with the Texas Secretary of
State. (The right to do business in Texas).
