The following is a briefing item to advise the Commission of staff's intent to enter into a proprietary promotional and sponsorship agreement with the ARK Group of Irving, Inc. for the Irving Music Factory.

Description	The Texas Lottery intends to enter into a proprietary Promotional and Sponsorship Agreement with ARK Group of Irving, Inc. a Texas corporation that owns and/or has rights to the Music Factory Facility at Las Colinas in Irving, Texas (a combination of an indoor/outdoor music pavilion, an outdoor event plaza, and an entertainment district serving the Dallas-Fort Worth metroplex), for retail space for Texas Lottery sales kiosks and promotional events at the Facility, together with marketing, advertising and promotional support for Texas Lottery games (including the rights to place Texas Lottery advertisements in the plaza, the rights to use the Facility trademarks, and promotions through Live Nation).
