Re: 87th Legislature – Legislative Appropriations Request for FY 2022-23

The attached document provides a summary of the Commission's Senate Bill 1 appropriation funding for FY 2022-23 following adoption of the budget by the Senate Bill 1 Conference Committee. The budget bill is still subject to line item veto by the Governor.

Baseline budget funding

The budget approved by the Conference Committee includes a net decrease of \$15,899,731 from our current baseline budget for the Lottery Dedicated Account. This budget reduction reduces the Promote Lottery Games Contract budget from \$17.9 million in each year of the biennium to \$10.0 million per year. Commission staff is taking measures to adjust the FY 2022 Marketing Plan to reflect the updated annual budget of \$10.0 million. Revisions that are underway include:

- Eliminating all 52 weeks of radio live reads and all 20 weeks of radio for scratch ticket campaigns,
- Eliminating paid social media support for all scratch ticket campaigns,
- Reducing scratch ticket media campaign flights from 5 to 3 with digital video and audio and billboards only,
- Reducing Out of Home Billboards for scratch ticket campaigns from 18 markets statewide to 4 markets,
- Reducing Jackpot Out of Home Billboards from 110 to 92-98.

The Bingo program funded by General Revenue is fully funded at baseline budget levels.

Exceptional Item funding

The Commission had requested \$2.2 million in each year of the biennium that would allow for the \$4.2 million annual retailer bonus budget to be fully restored in the FY 2022-23 biennium. The increased funding for this program was not adopted in Senate Bill 1.

Rider Request

The Rider requested for Unexpended Balances of Capital Budget for the Construction of 1801 Congress is included in the final approved budget. Should any of the FY 2021 capital expenditures


for building construction be deferred to FY 2022, this appropriation will provide for expenditures that may be required in FY 2022.
