

1 The Texas Lottery Commission (Commission) adopts new 16 TAC §401.323
2 (“MONOPOLY MILLIONAIRES’ CLUB™” Game Rule). The new rule is adopted with non-
3 substantive changes to the proposed text as published in the July 4, 2014, issue of the *Texas*
4 *Register* (39 TexReg 5029). These changes from the published proposal affect the
5 administration of the game by the Multi-State Lottery Association (MUSL) and the National
6 Premium Game Group Lotteries that will offer the MONOPOLY MILLIONAIRES’ CLUB
7 game, but do not directly impact players or change how the game is played. The purpose of the
8 new rule is to establish and share with the public the details of the game design, matrix, prize
9 level structure and operation of the new MUSL national premium lottery draw game. The
10 Commission anticipates sales for the new game will start on or about October 19, 2014, and the
11 first drawing for the new game will occur on or about October 24, 2014, such dates being subject
12 to change by MUSL and/or the Commission’s Executive Director.

13 Specifically, the adopted version of the rule makes conforming changes consistent with
14 recent revisions made by MUSL, including the following: (1) the trademark designation for the
15 game now reads “MONOPOLY MILLIONAIRES’ CLUB™”; (2) the official name for the
16 jackpot prize will be “Top Prize” instead of “Jackpot Prize”; (3) the name of the million dollar
17 prizes drawn when the Top Prize is won will be “Millionaires’ Club Prize” instead of
18 “MONOPOLY Club Prize”; (4) the term “Jackpot Prize Pool” will be changed to the “Top Prize
19 and Millionaires’ Club Prize Pool” (TP&MC Prize Pool) to fund both prizes and to include the
20 contributions for both prizes less the amount to fund the Prize Reserve Account (PRA); (5) the
21 terms “MONOPOLY Club Prize Pool” and the “Set-Aside Prize Pool” will be deleted because
22 these funds are now provided for in the TP&MC Prize Pool and the PRA, respectively; (6) the
23 last sentence in subsection (d)(1) will be deleted because it is redundant of language in

1 subsection (d)(2)(E); (7) required “approval” will be changed to “review and comment” of the
2 MUSL Finance & Audit Committee in subsection (d)(2)(D); (8) Figure 16 TAC
3 §401.323(d)(3)(A) will be amended to use four decimal points for the sales percentages, to
4 update prize pool percentages and prize levels (1-11 instead of 1-10), and to correct the Top
5 Prize & Millionaires’ Club Prize percentage (%) of the Prize Pool from 64.4298 to 64.4296; (9)
6 subsection (d)(3)(C)(i) has been deleted and subsection (d)(3)(C)(ii) has been revised to
7 incorporate terms from the deleted subsection; (10) in subsection (e)(1)(B), a reference has been
8 added relating to subsection (e)(4); (11) annuity factor determinations from subsection (e)(1)(B)
9 have been deleted and moved to subsection (e)(4); (12) subsection (e)(8) adds a disclaimer
10 making the subsection subject to state law and Commission rules; (13) at subsections (f)(4) and
11 (f)(5), the word “other” has been deleted and replaced with “any of the”; (14) subsection
12 (g)(1)(D) adds Hasbro directors, officers and employees to the ineligible players list; (15)
13 subsection (g)(1)(E) makes re-lettering changes; and (16) at subsection (i)(6) the language “may
14 permit or require” and “or the Commission requires” has been added for clarification purposes.

15 Additionally, the adopted version of the rule corrects typographical errors, and in
16 subsection (e)(2,) adds “for tickets sold by licensed sales agents in Texas and validated according
17 to Commission rules,” clarifying that the Texas Lottery will not pay prizes on tickets sold in
18 other jurisdictions, deletes “may be paid” as it is unnecessary language, and adds “Set Prize” for
19 clarification.

20 A public comment hearing was held on Tuesday, July 22, 2014 at 11 a.m., at 611 E. 6th
21 Street, Austin, Texas 78701. No members of the public were present at the hearing. The
22 Commission received no written comments from any individuals during the public comment
23 period.

1 The new rule is adopted under Texas Government Code Ann. §§466.015(c)(1)-(4), which
2 authorize the Commission to adopt rules governing the operation of the lottery, including rules
3 governing the type of lottery games to be conducted, the price of each ticket, the number of
4 winning tickets and the amount of the prize paid on each winning ticket, and the frequency of the
5 drawing or selection of a winning ticket; and under the authority of Texas Government Code
6 Ann. §467.102, which authorizes the Commission to adopt rules for the enforcement and
7 administration of the laws under the Commission’s jurisdiction.

8 This adoption implements Chapter 466 of the Texas Government Code.

9 §401.323. “MONOPOLY MILLIONAIRES’ CLUB™” Game Rule.

10 (a) MONOPOLY MILLIONAIRES’ CLUB. MONOPOLY MILLIONAIRES’ CLUB is a
11 Multi-State Lottery Association (MUSL) national premium draw game offered by all Lotteries
12 that have agreed to MUSL’s National Premium Game Product Group Rules. MONOPOLY
13 MILLIONAIRES’ CLUB is authorized to be conducted in Texas by the executive director in
14 accordance with the MUSL rules, the laws of the State of Texas, this section, and under such
15 further instructions, directives, and procedures as the executive director may issue in
16 conformance with state law. If a conflict arises between this section and §401.304 of this chapter
17 (relating to On-line Game Rules (General)), this section shall have precedence. The purpose of
18 the MONOPOLY MILLIONAIRES’ CLUB game is the generation of revenue through the
19 operation of a specially designed, national premium multi-jurisdiction lottery draw game that
20 will award MONOPOLY MILLIONAIRES’ CLUB prizes and, only when a Top Prize has been
21 won in a MONOPOLY MILLIONAIRES’ CLUB drawing, \$1 million Millionaires’ Club prizes.
22 In addition to other applicable rules contained in Chapter 401, this section and definitions apply
23 unless the context requires a different meaning or is otherwise inconsistent with the intention of

1 the rules adopted by MUSL or the MUSL National Premium Game Product Group. The conduct
2 and play of MONOPOLY MILLIONAIRES' CLUB must conform to the MUSL National
3 Premium Game Product Group MONOPOLY MILLIONAIRES' CLUB Game Rules.

4 (b) Definitions.

5 (1) "Game board", "board", "panel", or "playboard" means that area of the playslip
6 which contains one set of numbered squares to be marked by the player, or, at the player's option
7 by marking the appropriate box on the playboard, selected as a Quick Pick, containing fifty-two
8 (52) squares, numbered one (1) through fifty-two (52). One (1) of twenty-eight (28) numbered
9 MONOPOLY game board properties will be assigned to the player as a Quick Pick with each
10 MONOPOLY MILLIONAIRES' CLUB ticket purchase.

11 (2) "Top Prize" means the game prize (*see* Figure 16 TAC §401.323(d)(3)(A), Prize
12 Level 1) won when a player's wager matches all six (6) numbers, the first five (5) from a field of
13 fifty-two (52) numbers and one (1) from a field of twenty-eight (28) numbered MONOPOLY
14 game board properties.

15 (3) "Lottery" means a state lottery or lottery of a governmental unit, political subdivision
16 or entity thereof that has agreed to MUSL's MONOPOLY MILLIONAIRES' CLUB Game
17 Rules and is selling the game offered by the MUSL National Premium Game Product Group.

18 (4) "Lotteries" refers to the Lotteries participating in the MUSL National Premium Game
19 Product Group.

20 (5) "Millionaires' Club Prize" means a single payment prize (*See* 16 TAC
21 §401.323(d)(3)(A)) with a value of one million dollars (\$1,000,000). Only when a Top Prize has
22 been won in a MONOPOLY MILLIONAIRES' CLUB drawing, a second drawing will be held
23 to select Millionaires' Club Prize winning tickets.

1 (6) "MUSL" means the Multi-State Lottery Association, a government-benefit
2 association wholly owned and operated by its Member Lotteries, which acts as the central office
3 for the Lotteries in the MUSL National Premium Game Product Group.

4 (7) "MUSL Board" means the governing body of MUSL which is comprised of the chief
5 executive officer of each MUSL Member Lottery.

6 (8) "Play" or "wager" means the six (6) numbers, the first five (5) from a field of fifty-
7 two (52) numbers and the last one (1) from a field of twenty-eight (28) numbered MONOPOLY
8 game board properties, that appear on a ticket as a single numbered selection and are to be
9 played by a player in the game.

10 (9) "Playslip" means an optically readable card issued by the Commission used by
11 players of MONOPOLY MILLIONAIRES' CLUB to select plays and to elect all features. A
12 playslip has no pecuniary value and shall not constitute evidence of ticket purchase or of
13 numbers selected. Playslips must be completed manually. A ticket generated from a playslip that
14 was not completed manually is not valid. There shall be four (4) playboards on each playslip.

15 (10) "MUSL National Premium Game Product Group" or "Product Group" means the
16 group of Lotteries that has joined together to offer the MONOPOLY MILLIONAIRES' CLUB
17 lottery game pursuant to the terms of the Multi-State Lottery Agreement and the Product Group's
18 MONOPOLY MILLIONAIRES' CLUB Game Rules.

19 (11) "Set Prize" or "Low-Tier prizes" (Prize Levels 2-10) means all other prizes, except
20 the Top Prize and Millionaires' Club Prizes, that are advertised to be paid in a single payment
21 and, except in instances outlined in this rule, are established by the Product Group for each prize
22 level.

1 (12) "Terminal" means a device authorized by the Commission to function in an
2 interactive mode with the lottery's central gaming system for the purpose of issuing lottery
3 tickets and entering, receiving, and processing lottery transactions, including making purchases,
4 validating tickets, and transmitting reports.

5 (13) "Winning Numbers" means the six (6) numbers, the first five (5) from a field of
6 fifty-two (52) numbers and the last one (1) from a field of twenty-eight (28) numbers that also
7 represent MONOPOLY game board properties, randomly selected at each drawing, which shall
8 be used to determine winning plays contained on a game ticket.

9 (c) Game Description.

10 (1) How to Play. MONOPOLY MILLIONAIRES' CLUB is a five (5) out of fifty-two
11 (52) plus one (1) out of twenty-eight (28) lottery draw game, drawn every Friday (or such other
12 day of the week as required by the Product Group's MONOPOLY MILLIONAIRES' CLUB
13 Game Rules), which pays the Top Prize at the election of the player or by a default election made
14 in accordance with this rule, either on an annuitized pari-mutuel basis or a cash lump sum
15 payment of the total cash held for this prize pool on a pari-mutuel basis.

16 Only when a Top Prize has been won in a MONOPOLY MILLIONAIRES' CLUB
17 drawing, a second drawing will be held to select Millionaires' Club Prize winning tickets. At the
18 start of each new MONOPOLY MILLIONAIRES' CLUB roll cycle, ten (10) Millionaires' Club
19 Prizes will be available. As determined by the Product Group, more Millionaires' Club Prizes
20 may be added, during the roll cycle, with each drawing until the Top Prize is won and the
21 Millionaires' Club Prizes are drawn. A given play may win in the MONOPOLY
22 MILLIONAIRES' CLUB drawing, the Millionaires' Club Prize drawing (if any), or both
23 drawings. MONOPOLY MILLIONAIRES' CLUB and Millionaires' Club Prize drawings shall

1 use random number generators, and otherwise shall be determined by the Product Group. All
2 Millionaires' Club prizes and MONOPOLY MILLIONAIRES' CLUB Set Prizes (all prizes
3 except the Top Prize) are paid as a single payment.

4 To play MONOPOLY MILLIONAIRES' CLUB a player shall select, or use Quick Pick
5 to choose, five (5) different numbers from one (1) through fifty-two (52); the additional number
6 in the range from one (1) through twenty-eight (28) shall always be a randomly generated Quick
7 Pick number for the second value in the player's selection. The second number may be the same
8 as one of the first five numbers selected by the player. The second number shall be represented
9 on the player's ticket both as a number and as the associated MONOPOLY game board property.
10 Each play shall also have a unique, non-repeating transactional number associated with that play
11 to be used in determining Millionaires' Club Prize winning plays, only in the event the Top Prize
12 is won and a separate Millionaires' Club Prize drawing is held.

13 (2) Plays and Ticket Purchases. Plays can be purchased for five dollars (U.S. \$5.00) and
14 may be sold only by an on-line licensed sales agent and only at the location listed on the sales
15 agent's license. A ticket sold by a person other than an on-line licensed sales agent is not valid.

16 (3) Claims. A valid ticket shall be the only proof of a game play, and the submission of a
17 valid winning ticket to the Commission or its authorized sales agent shall be the sole method of
18 claiming a prize or prizes. A playslip has no pecuniary or prize value and shall not constitute
19 evidence of ticket purchase or of numbers selected. A terminal-produced paper receipt has no
20 pecuniary or prize value and shall not constitute evidence of ticket purchase or of numbers
21 selected.

22 (4) Cancellations Prohibited. A MONOPOLY MILLIONAIRES' CLUB ticket may not
23 be voided or canceled, even when printed in error. No ticket which can be used to claim a prize

1 shall be returned to the Commission for credit. Tickets accepted by licensed sales agents as
2 returned tickets and which cannot be re-sold shall be deemed owned by the bearer thereof.

3 (5) Player Responsibility. It shall be the sole responsibility of the player to verify the
4 accuracy of the game play or plays and other data printed on the ticket. The placing of plays is
5 done at the player's own risk through the licensed sales agent who is acting on behalf of the
6 player in entering the play or plays.

7 (6) Entry of Plays. Plays may only be entered manually using the licensed sales agent
8 terminal touch screen or by means of a playslip provided by the Commission and hand-marked
9 by the player or by such other means approved by the Commission. Licensed sales agents shall
10 not permit the use of facsimiles of playslips, copies of playslips, or other materials that are
11 inserted into the terminal's playslip reader that are not approved by the Commission. Licensed
12 sales agents shall not permit any device to be connected to a lottery terminal to enter plays,
13 except as approved by the Commission.

14 (d) Prize Pool and Prize Reserve.

15 (1) Prize Pool. The prize pool for all prize categories shall consist of fifty percent
16 (50.00%) of each drawing period's sales, after the prize pool accounts and prize reserve accounts
17 are funded to the amounts set by the Product Group.

18 (2) Prize Pool Accounts and Prize Reserve Accounts.

19 (A) MUSL will deduct an amount up to four percent (4%) of the Texas
20 Lottery's MONOPOLY MILLIONAIRES' CLUB sales from the MONOPOLY
21 MILLIONAIRES' CLUB Top Prize contribution and Millionaires' Club Prize Pool contribution
22 and place in trust in one or more prize pool accounts and prize reserve accounts until the prize

1 pool accounts and the Texas Lottery's share of the prize reserve account(s) reach the amounts
2 designated by the Product Group.

3 (B) The prize pool accounts established for the MONOPOLY
4 MILLIONAIRES' CLUB game include:

5 (i) Top Prize and Millionaires' Club Prize Pool (TP&MC Prize Pool),
6 which is used to fund the immediate Top Prize and Millionaires' Club Prizes and shall consist of
7 the Top Prize and Millionaires' Club Prize Pool contributions less amounts to fund the Prize
8 Reserve Account (PRA); and

9 (ii) Set Prize Pool Account, which holds the temporary balances that may
10 result from having fewer than expected winning plays in the Set Prize categories. The source of
11 the Set Prize Pool Account is the participating Lotteries' weekly prize contributions less actual
12 Set Prize liability.

13 (C) The Prize Reserve Account is established for the MONOPOLY
14 MILLIONAIRES' CLUB game, which is used to guarantee the payment of the minimum or
15 starting Top Prize and Millionaires' Club Prizes, guarantee the payment of valid, but
16 unanticipated, Top Prize and Millionaires' Club Prize claims that may result from a system error
17 or other reason, and to fund deficiencies in Set Prize payments (subject to the limitations of this
18 rule).

19 (D) Once the prize pool accounts and the Commission's share of the PRA
20 exceed the designated amounts, the excess shall become part of the TP&MC Prize Pool. The
21 Product Group, with review and comment of the MUSL Finance & Audit Committee, may
22 establish a maximum balance for the prize pool accounts and the PRA.

1 (E) The Product Group may determine to expend all or a portion of the funds
2 in the PRA and the Set Prize Pool Account: (1) for the purpose of indemnifying the Lotteries in
3 the payment of prizes to be made by the Lotteries, subject to the approval of the MUSL Board;
4 and (2) for the payment of prizes or special prizes in the MONOPOLY MILLIONAIRES' CLUB
5 game, limited to Set Prize Pool and prize reserve contributions from Lotteries participating in the
6 special prize promotion, subject to the review and comment of the MUSL Finance and Audit
7 Committee. The prize reserve shares of a Lottery may be adjusted with refunds to the Lottery
8 from the PRA as may be needed to maintain the approved maximum balance and shares of the
9 Lotteries. As approved by the Product Group, any amount remaining in the prize pool accounts
10 or PRA when the Product Group declares the end of the MONOPOLY MILLIONAIRES' CLUB
11 game shall be returned to all Lotteries participating in the accounts after the end of all applicable
12 claim periods of all Lotteries, carried forward to the replacement PRA or expended in a manner
13 as directed by the individual Lotteries in accordance with jurisdictional requirements.

14 (3) Expected Prize Payout Percentages, Prize Pool Funding and Fund Transfers.

15 (A) The Top Prize shall be determined on a pari-mutuel basis. The following
16 table sets forth the probability of winning plays and the probable distribution of winning plays in
17 and among each prize category, based upon the total number of possible combinations in
18 MONOPOLY MILLIONAIRES' CLUB, and prize pool funding by prize category. Except as
19 otherwise provided for in this rule, all other prizes awarded shall be paid as Set Prizes with the
20 following expected prize payout percentages:

(B) The prize money allocated to the Top Prize category shall be divided equally by the number of plays winning the Top Prize.

(C) Prize Pool Account Rollovers and Carry Forwards.

(i) Any monies not paid for Top Prize and Millionaires' Club Prizes in the TP&MC Prize Pool following a drawing shall roll over and be added to the TP&MC Prize Pool for the following drawing.

(ii) The Set Prize Pool for prizes of one hundred thousand dollars

1 (\$100,000.00) or less shall be carried forward to subsequent draws if all or a portion of it is not
2 needed to pay the Set Prizes awarded in the current draw.

3 (D) Pari-Mutuel Prize Determinations.

4 (i) If the total of the Set Prizes awarded in a drawing (prize levels 2-10)
5 exceeds the percentage of the prize pool allocated to the Set Prizes, then the amount needed to
6 fund the Set Prizes awarded shall be drawn from the following sources, in the following order:
7 (1) the amount allocated to the Set Prizes and carried forward from previous draws, if any; (2) an
8 amount from the PRA, if available, not to exceed twenty million dollars (\$20,000,000.00) per
9 drawing.

10 (ii) If, after these sources are depleted, there are not sufficient funds to
11 pay the Set Prizes awarded, then the highest Set Prize shall become a pari-mutuel prize. If the
12 amount of the highest Set Prize, when paid on a pari-mutuel basis, drops to or below the next
13 highest Set Prize and there are still not sufficient funds to pay the remaining Set Prizes awarded,
14 then the next highest Set Prize shall become a pari-mutuel prize. This procedure shall continue
15 down through all Set Prize levels, if necessary, until all Set Prize levels become pari-mutuel
16 prize levels.

17 (E) Fund Transfers. On a weekly basis, or as otherwise determined by the
18 Product Group, the Commission will transfer, in trust, an amount as determined by the Product
19 Group to be the Commission's total proportionate share of the MONOPOLY MILLIONAIRES'
20 CLUB license and vendor fees, which include the television game show prizes, and studio
21 audience member travel expenses.

22 (F) Unclaimed Top Prizes and Millionaires' Club Prizes. All funds to pay a
23 Top Prize or Millionaires' Club Prize that had been collected by the MUSL central office and

1 that went unclaimed shall be returned to the Lotteries in proportion to sales by the Lotteries for
2 the prize(s) in question, after the claiming period set by the Lottery selling the winning ticket
3 expires.

4 (e) Prize Payment.

5 (1) Top Prizes.

6 (A) The Top Prize shall begin at an annuitized amount of Fifteen Million Dollars
7 (\$15,000,000.00) and shall increase following each consecutive drawing in which the Top Prize
8 is not won, except that the annuitized Top Prize amount shall not exceed Twenty-five Million
9 Dollars (\$25,000,000.00) and will remain at this amount for each subsequent drawing until the
10 Top Prize is won.

11 Top Prizes shall be paid as an annuity or a single lump-sum payment. At the time
12 of ticket purchase, a player may select the option for payment of the cash value or annuitized
13 payments of a share of the Top Prize if the play is a winning play. If no payment option is
14 selected by the player, the default payment option will be the cash value option. Selection of the
15 option for payment of the cash value or annuitized payments of a share of the Top Prize if the
16 play is a winning play is a selection made at the time of purchase and is final and cannot be
17 revoked, withdrawn or otherwise changed.

18 (B) Shares of the Top Prize shall be determined as provided in subsection (e)(4). A
19 player(s) who elects a single lump-sum payment (cash value payment) shall be paid his/her
20 share(s) in a single cash payment. If individual shares of the cash held to fund an annuity are less
21 than \$250,000, the Commission, in its sole discretion, may elect to pay the holders of tickets with
22 winning plays their share of the funds of the cash pool to fund the annuity prizes as described in
23 subsection (e)(4).

1 (C) All annuitized prizes shall be paid annually in thirty (30) payments with the
2 initial payment being made in cash, to be followed by twenty-nine (29) payments funded by the
3 annuity. All annuitized prizes shall be paid annually in thirty (30) graduated payments
4 (increasing each year) at a rate as determined by the Product Group. Prize payments may be
5 rounded down to the nearest one thousand dollars (\$1,000). Annual payments after the initial
6 payment shall be made by the Lottery on the anniversary date or if such date falls on a non-
7 business day, then the first business day following the anniversary date of the selection of the
8 Top winning numbers. Funds for the initial payment of an annuitized prize or the single lump-
9 sum cash prize shall be made available by MUSL for payment by the Lottery no earlier than the
10 fifteenth calendar day (or the next banking day if the fifteenth day is a holiday) following the
11 drawing. If necessary, when the due date for the payment of a prize occurs before the receipt of
12 funds in the prize pool account sufficient to pay the prize, the transfer of funds for the payment
13 of the full lump-sum cash amount may be delayed pending receipt of funds from all Lotteries.
14 The identification of the securities to fund the annuitized prize shall be at the sole discretion of
15 the State of Texas. If the State of Texas purchases the securities, or holds the prize payment
16 annuity for a Top Prize won in this state, the prize winner will have no recourse against MUSL
17 or any other Lottery for payment of that prize.

18 (D) Payment of Prize Payments upon the Death of a Prize Winner. In the event of
19 the death of a prize winner, payments may be made in accordance with §401.310 of this chapter
20 (relating to Payment of Prize Payments Upon Death of Prize Winner); otherwise, payment of
21 prize payments will be made to the estate of a deceased prize winner in accordance with Texas
22 Government Code §466.406.

1 (2) Millionaires' Club and Set Prize Payments. All Millionaires' Club Prizes and Set
2 Prizes (all prizes except the Top Prize, whether described as "cash" payment prizes or otherwise)
3 for tickets sold by licensed sales agents in Texas and validated according to the Commission's
4 rules shall be paid by the Commission and at the discretion of the Commission by check,
5 warrant, or wire transfer. The Commission may begin paying Millionaires' Club Prizes and Set
6 Prizes after receiving authorization to pay from the MUSL central office.

7 (3) Prizes Rounded. Annuitized payments of the Top Prize or a share of the Top Prize
8 may be rounded to facilitate the purchase of an appropriate funding mechanism. Breakage on an
9 annuitized Top Prize win shall be added to the first payment to the verified winner or winners.
10 Set Prizes, which, under this rule, may become single-payment, pari-mutuel prizes, may be
11 rounded down so that prizes can be paid in multiples of whole dollars. Breakage resulting from
12 rounding Set Prizes shall be carried forward to the prize pool for the next drawing.

13 (4) Funding of Guaranteed Prizes. The Product Group may offer guaranteed minimum
14 Top Prize amounts, guaranteed minimum numbers of Millionaires' Club winners, minimum
15 increases in the Top Prize amount between drawings, minimum increases in the number of
16 Millionaires' Club winners between drawings, or make other changes in the allocation of prize
17 money where the Product Group finds that it would be in the best interest of the game. If a
18 minimum Top Prize amount or a minimum increase in the Top Prize between drawings is offered
19 by the Product Group, then shares of the Top Prize shall be determined as follows: If there are
20 multiple Top Prize winning plays during a single drawing, each selecting the annuitized option
21 prize, then a winning play's share of the guaranteed annuitized Top Prize shall be determined by
22 dividing the guaranteed annuitized Top Prize by the number of winning plays. If there are
23 multiple Top Prize winning plays during a single drawing and at least one (1) of the Top Prize

1 claimants has elected the annuitized option prize, then the best bid submitted by the MUSL
2 central office's pre-approved qualified brokers shall determine the cash pool needed to fund the
3 guaranteed annuitized Top Prize. If no claimant of the Top Prize during a single drawing has
4 elected the annuitized option prize, then the amount of cash in the Top Prize Pool shall be an
5 amount equal to the guaranteed annuitized amount divided by the average annuity factor of the
6 most recent three (3) best quotes provided by pre-approved qualified brokers submitting quotes.
7 In no case shall quotes be used which are more than two (2) weeks old, and if less than three (3)
8 quotes are submitted, then the MUSL central office shall use the average of all quotes submitted.
9 Changes in the allocation of prize money shall be designed to retain approximately the same
10 prize allocation percentages, over a year's time, as set out in MUSL's MONOPOLY
11 MILLIONAIRES' CLUB Game Rules. Minimum guaranteed prizes or increases may be waived
12 if the alternate funding mechanism set out in subsection (d)(3)(D) of this rule becomes
13 necessary. The annuity factor is determined by the best total securities price obtained through a
14 competitive bid of qualified, pre-approved brokers made after it is determined that the prize is to
15 be paid as an annuity prize. Neither MUSL, the Product Group, nor the Lotteries shall be
16 responsible or liable for changes in the advertised or estimated annuity prize amount and the
17 actual amount purchased after the prize payment method is actually known to the MUSL central
18 office.

19 (5) Prize Limited to Highest Prize Won. Except for the Millionaires' Club Prizes, the
20 holder of a winning ticket may win only one (1) prize for that ticket's play and shall be entitled
21 only to the prize won by those numbers in the highest matching prize category. The status of a
22 ticket with a winning play based on a match between the play and the Winning Numbers on that
23 ticket shall have no effect on that ticket's ability to win (if drawn) a Millionaires' Club Prize.

1 (6) Millionaires' Club Prize. Independent of a ticket's status as an apparent winning
2 ticket due to a match with the Winning Numbers, each ticket in a MONOPOLY
3 MILLIONAIRES' CLUB drawing is eligible to win a Millionaires' Club Prize if (and only if),
4 on that game draw, Millionaires' Club Prizes are awarded. If a ticket is a winning play under
5 both drawings, the prize paid shall be the sum of both the Top Prize or Set Prize (Level 2-10
6 prizes) and the Millionaires' Club Prize. At the start of each new MONOPOLY
7 MILLIONAIRES' CLUB roll cycle, ten (10) Millionaires' Club Prizes will be available. As
8 determined by the Product Group, more Millionaires' Club Prizes may be added, during the roll
9 cycle, with each drawing until the Top Prize is won and the Millionaires' Club Prizes are drawn.

10 (7) Prize Claim Period. Prize claims shall be submitted no later than 180 days after the
11 draw date.

12 (8) Prize Winners. Subject to state law and rules of the Commission, the name and city
13 of the winner of a Top Prize or Millionaires' Club Prize will be disclosed in a press conference
14 or in a press release, and the prize winner may be requested to participate in a press conference.
15 For legal entities, the name of a natural person who is a principal of the legal entity must be
16 provided.

17 (f) Ticket Claim and Validation.

18 (1) Prize Claims. Prize claim procedures shall be governed by the rules of the
19 Commission as set out in § 401.304 of this chapter and any internal procedures used by the
20 Commission. Neither MUSL, the Product Group, nor the other participating Lotteries shall be
21 responsible for prizes that are not claimed following the proper procedures as determined by the
22 Commission.

1 (2) Signature. Until such time as a signature is placed upon a ticket in the area designated
2 for signature, a ticket shall be owned by the bearer of the ticket.

3 (3) Multiple Claimants. The issue of multiple claimants shall be handled in accordance
4 with Texas Government Code Chapter 466 and §401.304 of this chapter.

5 (4) Stolen Tickets. Neither MUSL, the Product Group, nor any of the participating
6 Lotteries shall be responsible for lost or stolen tickets.

7 (5) Ticket Validation. To be a valid ticket and eligible to receive a prize, a ticket shall
8 satisfy all the requirements established by the Commission for validation of winning tickets sold
9 through the Texas Lottery's gaming system and any other validation requirements adopted by the
10 Lotteries, the Product Group, and the MUSL Board. Neither MUSL, the Product Group, nor any
11 of the participating Lotteries shall be responsible for paying prizes for tickets which are altered
12 in any manner.

13 (g) Ineligible Players.

14 (1) A ticket or share for the MONOPOLY MILLIONAIRES' CLUB Game shall not be
15 purchased by, and a prize won by any such ticket or share shall not be paid to:

16 (A) any MUSL employee, officer, or Product Group Lottery Director;

17 (B) any contractor or consultant under agreement with MUSL to review MUSL
18 audit and security procedures;

19 (C) any employee of an independent accounting firm under contract with MUSL
20 to observe drawings or site operations who is actually assigned to the MUSL account and all
21 partners, shareholders, or owners in the local office of the firm; or

22 (D) Any officer, employee or director of Hasbro, Inc., or

1 (E) an immediate family member (parent, stepparent, child, stepchild, spouse or
2 sibling) of an individual described in subparagraphs (A), (B,) (C) or (D) of this paragraph and
3 residing in the same household.

4 (2) Those persons designated by a Lottery as ineligible to play its games also shall be
5 ineligible to play the MONOPOLY MILLIONAIRES' CLUB game in any Lottery jurisdiction.

6 (h) Applicable Law. In purchasing a ticket in Texas, the purchaser agrees to comply with and
7 abide by all applicable laws, rules, regulations, procedures, and decisions of the Commission.

8 (i) MONOPOLY MILLIONAIRES' CLUB Television Game Show.

9 (1) Television Game Show. The Product Group may decide to add a television game
10 show to the MONOPOLY MILLIONAIRES' CLUB game. The MONOPOLY
11 MILLIONAIRES' CLUB television game show (TV Show) will be produced at times and places
12 approved by the Product Group for broadcast at times approved by the Product Group.

13 (2) Basic TV Show Design; Alterations. The basic design of the TV Show shall be as
14 described in this subsection, except that any alteration of the basic design of the TV Show may
15 be approved by the Product Group. Contests played on the TV Show shall be as approved by the
16 Product Group.

17 (3) Eligibility. Unless otherwise indicated by the Commission, a Texas Lottery player
18 may become eligible for TV Show studio audience member selection by registering a
19 MONOPOLY MILLIONAIRES' CLUB ticket or tickets with one or more qualifying
20 MONOPOLY game board properties according to the requirements of this game rule. Members
21 of the studio audience shall be eligible to be selected to participate in MONOPOLY-themed
22 contests on the TV Show. Guests of players who are not proxied by the player to appear as an

1 on-stage participant in the place of the player are not eligible to be selected as an on-stage game
2 participant.

3 (4) How to Register. To register a MONOPOLY MILLIONAIRES' CLUB ticket for
4 participation in the selection of studio audience members, a Texas Lottery player must visit the
5 Commission's LuckZone website, where the player will be asked to sign into his/her existing
6 LuckZone account or open a new account and enter the webcode printed on the MONOPOLY
7 MILLIONAIRES' CLUB ticket. The MONOPOLY game board property on the ticket, together
8 with a randomly generated additional bonus MONOPOLY game board property assigned when
9 the ticket is registered at the LuckZone website, will be put in the player's account. As shown in
10 the following table, for each complete MONOPOLY property group, the player will be awarded
11 a number of entries in a drawing from which studio audience members will be selected.

14 (5) Selection of Studio Audience Members. The Commission (or its authorized
15 designee) shall, from time to time as specified by the Product Group, conduct a promotional
16 drawing from among those MONOPOLY MILLIONAIRES' CLUB registered Texas Lottery
17 LuckZone account holders who have accumulated enough MONOPOLY properties to participate
18 in the drawing. For each drawing, the Commission shall select a minimum of three (3) studio

1 audience participants, each of whom shall be awarded: i) transportation, meals, and lodging
2 expenses for himself or herself and a guest to travel to and return from the TV Show; and ii) the
3 opportunity to be chosen as an on-stage participant on the TV Show and play MONOPOLY-
4 themed contests for prizes.

5 (6) No transfers; No cash option; Exceptions. A Texas Lottery player selected to
6 participate as a studio audience member for the TV Show shall not have the right to transfer such
7 selection to another person, except that the Commission, in its sole discretion, may permit or
8 require the player to appoint another person to participate as a studio audience member (a proxy),
9 subject to player eligibility requirements set by the Commission. If the player selects, or the
10 Commission requires, a proxy to participate as a studio audience member in his/her place, the
11 transportation, meals, and lodging expenses, together with any prize(s) awarded as a result of
12 participation in the studio audience or in a contest on the TV Show shall be deemed to be
13 received by the player initially selected to participate, not the proxy. Nothing in this rule
14 requires the Commission to permit studio audience members to appoint a replacement to attend
15 the TV Show taping. A player selected to participate as a studio audience member for the TV
16 Show shall not have the right to decline the payment of expenses for transportation, meals, and
17 lodging in exchange for a sum of money equivalent to the value of such expenses. The
18 Commission, in its sole discretion, may select another player to attend the TV show taping
19 should the player initially selected to participate in the studio audience decline the invitation or
20 be determined to be ineligible to claim such prize under the State Lottery Act, this Chapter, or
21 other Texas law. Nothing in this rule requires the Commission to offer a cash option in lieu of
22 the opportunity to attend the TV Show.
