LOTTO TEXAS® JACKPOT PRIZE REMAINS UNCLAIMED; TICKET TO EXPIRE MAY 14

Jackpot-winning ticket was purchased in Brownsville for drawing held last November

AUSTIN – A jackpot-winning ticket for the [Lotto Texas® drawing held on Nov. 15, 2025](#) will soon expire. The winning ticket, for the estimated annuitized \$78 million jackpot, was purchased at Gordon's Bait & Tackle, located at 7066 Padre Island Highway, in Brownsville, but the prize has not been claimed and **will expire on Thursday, May 14, if not validated by the deadline**. The winning ticket with player-selected numbers matched all six of the numbers drawn (7-17-23-28-39-48). The cash value option was selected at the time of purchase and a claimant would receive \$43,757,223.10 before taxes.

To claim the prize, the ticket holder must call the Texas Lottery to make an appointment for processing and then present the ticket in person for validation at [Texas Lottery® headquarters](#), located at 1801 Congress Ave., in Austin, **by 5 p.m. CT on Thursday, May 14**.

A ticket holder forfeits any claim to a prize for a draw game after the expiration of the 180th day following the draw date. The deadline may be extended for a period of time for certain eligible military personnel. Unclaimed prizes revert back to the state for programs authorized by the Texas Legislature.

Lotto Texas is played by picking six numbers from one to 54 and offers multimillion-dollar jackpots. Drawings are held every Monday, Wednesday and Saturday at 10:12 p.m. CT. For \$1 more per Play, a player can select the Extra! add-on feature for a chance to win up to \$10,000 more on non-jackpot prizes. About the Texas Lottery
