**\$16.25 MILLION LOTTO TEXAS® JACKPOT-WINNING
TICKET SOLD IN FLOWER MOUND**

(AUSTIN) – A jackpot-winning ticket worth an estimated annuitized \$16.25 million for the [Lotto Texas® drawing held on Jan. 1](#) was purchased at RaceTrac #375, located at 1809 Justin Road, in Flower Mound. The winning Quick Pick ticket matched all six of the numbers drawn (1-16-19-39-42-46). The cash value option was selected at the time of purchase and the claimant will receive \$12,660,841.60 before taxes. The prize has not yet been claimed. The winner has 180 days from the draw date to claim the prize.

“It was a very happy new year for one lucky Texas Lottery® player, and we look forward to meeting the first Lotto Texas jackpot winner of 2022,” said Gary Grief, executive director of the Texas Lottery. “If you have the winning ticket, we encourage you to sign the ticket, put it in a safe place, seek financial and legal advice, and call the Texas Lottery to schedule an appointment to claim the prize.”

In addition to the jackpot-winning prize, 66,156 Lotto Texas tickets, including those with the Extra! add-on feature, won lower-tier prizes ranging from \$2 to \$11,629 for the same drawing. The jackpot for the next Lotto Texas drawing on Monday, Jan. 3 will reset to an estimated annuitized \$5 million.

Lotto Texas is played by picking six numbers from one to 54 and offers multimillion-dollar jackpots. Drawings are held every Monday, Wednesday and Saturday at 10:12 p.m. CT. For \$1 more per play, a player can select the Extra! add-on feature for a chance to win up to \$10,000 more on non-jackpot prizes.

About the Texas Lottery

Beginning with the first ticket sold in 1992, the Texas Lottery has generated \$34 billion in revenue for the state and distributed \$72 billion in prizes to lottery players. Since 1997, the Texas Lottery has contributed \$28 billion to the Foundation School Fund, which supports public education in Texas.
