## SAN ANTONIO RESIDENT CLAIMS \$1 MILLION SCRATCH TICKET PRIZE

(AUSTIN) - A San Antonio resident claimed a top prize winning ticket worth $\$ 1$ million in the Texas Lottery ${ }^{\circledR}$ scratch ticket game Millionaire Club. The ticket was purchased at H-E-B Food Store \#658, located at 23635 Wilderness Oak, in San Antonio. The claimant elected to remain anonymous.

This was the last of four top prizes worth $\$ 1$ million to be claimed in this game. Millionaire Club offers more than $\$ 262.6$ million in total prizes. Overall odds of winning a prize of $\$ 75$ or more in the game are one in 3.51 .
