# CONVERSE RESIDENT CLAIMS $\mathbf{\$ 2}$ MILLION POWERBALL ${ }^{\circledR}$ PRIZE <br> Winning ticket was purchased in San Antonio 

AUSTIN - A Converse resident claimed a Powerball ${ }^{\circledR}$ prize worth $\$ 2$ million for the drawing on May 15. The ticket was purchased at Z-Mart, located at 3818 Quiet Meadow St., in San Antonio. The claimant elected to remain anonymous.

The second-tier winning Quick Pick ticket with Power Play ${ }^{\circledR}$ matched all five of the white ball numbers drawn (1-26-28-55-58), but not the red Powerball number (25). The Power Play number was 2.

Powerball Grand Prizes currently start at $\$ 20$ million and roll until the jackpot is won. Players win the Grand Prize by matching five numbers from a field of 69 numbers and one Powerball number from a field of 26 numbers. By choosing Power Play ${ }^{\circledR}$ for $\$ 1$ more per Play, players can multiply their non-Grand Prize winnings by two, three, four, five or 10 times*. A Power Play Match Five $(5+0)$ prize is set at $\$ 2,000,000$ regardless of the Power Play number selected. All other non-Grand Prizes will be multiplied by the Power Play number selected. *The 10X Power Play multiplier is available for drawings in which the initially advertised annuitized Grand Prize amount is $\$ 150$ million or less. Drawings are broadcast each Monday, Wednesday and Saturday at 10:12 p.m. CT.
