# JACKPOT ALERT*** <br> TEXAS LOTTERY ${ }^{\circledR}$ PLAYERS SEEK TO EXTEND LUCKY WEEK IN \$1.72 BILLION POWERBALL ${ }^{\circledR}$ DRAWING TONIGHT <br> $2^{\text {nd }}$ largest jackpot in Powerball and U.S. lottery history 


#### Abstract

AUSTIN - It continues to climb! After no one won Monday night's Powerball ${ }^{\circledR}$ drawing, Texas Lottery ${ }^{\circledR}$ players are eyeing their next chance to become a big winner, as the game's Grand Prize has grown to an estimated annuitized $\$ 1.72$ billion for the Wednesday, Oct. 11 drawing. Tonight's Grand Prize is the largest jackpot of 2023 and is the second largest in Powerball and U.S. lottery history. The cash value for tonight's drawing is worth an estimated $\$ 756.6$ million. If there is no jackpot winner for tonight's Powerball drawing, the Grand Prize for the Saturday, Oct. 14 drawing will rise to an estimated annuitized $\$ 1.92$ billion.


"It's been an exciting week for Texas Lottery players, as five second-tier prize winning Powerball tickets have been sold in our state since last Wednesday in addition to Friday night's Mega Millions jackpot-winning ticket that was sold in San Angelo," said Gary Grief, executive director of the Texas Lottery. As this Powerball jackpot moves into record territory, our players are chomping at the bit for a chance to become the Texas Lottery's first billionaire. While we're hoping this streak of luck and big wins continue for our players tonight, we want to remind them to play responsibly. If it appears that you have the jackpot-winning ticket, we encourage you to sign the ticket, put it in a safe place, seek financial and legal advice and call the Texas Lottery to schedule an appointment to claim the prize."

So far in 2023, 25 second-tier Powerball prizes of $\$ 1$ million or larger have been sold to Texas Lottery ${ }^{\circledR}$ players, including eight during the current jackpot run, with five of those occurring over the last week (three on Oct. 4 and two on Oct. 7).

Wednesday's drawing will be the $36^{\text {th }}$ in the current Powerball jackpot run since starting as an estimated annuitized $\$ 20$ million for the July 22 drawing. This is the largest Powerball jackpot of 2023 and the biggest one up for grabs since the estimated $\$ 2.04$ billion jackpot for the Nov. 7, 2022 drawing, which was won in California. The current jackpot marks the first time that two consecutive jackpot runs have produced billion dollar jackpots in the Powerball game.

Since joining the Powerball game in 2010, Texas has had two Powerball Grand Prize winners, including its most recent in February 2015 when TL Management Trust, Andrew Weber, Trustee of Austin, claimed a share of the $\$ 564.1$ million Grand Prize with two other winners.

Powerball Grand Prizes currently start at $\$ 20$ million and roll until the jackpot is won. Players win the Grand Prize by matching five numbers from a field of 69 numbers and one Powerball number from a field of 26 numbers. By choosing Power Play ${ }^{\oplus}$ for $\$ 1$ more per Play, players can multiply their nonGrand Prize winnings by two, three, four, five or 10 times*. A Power Play Match Five (5+0) prize is set at $\$ 2,000,000$ regardless of the Power Play number selected. All other non-Grand Prizes will be multiplied by the Power Play number selected. *The 10X Power Play multiplier is available for drawings in which the initially advertised annuitized Grand Prize amount is $\$ 150$ million or less.

Drawings are broadcast each Monday, Wednesday and Saturday at 10:12 p.m. CT. Texas Lottery players can purchase Powerball tickets at more than 20,000 Texas Lottery retailers across the state. Ticket sales for the next Powerball drawing will close at 9 p.m. CT on Wednesday, Oct. 11 The retailer that sells a jackpot-winning Powerball ticket is eligible to receive up to a $\$ 1$ million retailer bonus.
