AUSTIN RESIDENT CLAIMS \$34 MILLION LOTTO TEXAS® JACKPOT

AUSTIN – An Austin resident claimed a Lotto Texas® jackpot prize worth an estimated annuitized \$34 million for the <u>drawing held on Dec. 30, 2023</u>. The cash value option was selected at the time of purchase and the claimant received \$20,205,534.60 before taxes.

The winning Quick Pick ticket matched all six of the numbers drawn (6-7-23-34-37-50). The ticket was purchased at H-E-B Food Store #096, located at 7025 Village Center Drive, in Austin. The claimant elected to remain anonymous.

Lotto Texas is played by picking six numbers from one to 54 and offers multimillion-dollar jackpots. Drawings are held every Monday, Wednesday and Saturday at 10:12 p.m. CT. For \$1 more per Play, a player can select the Extra! add-on feature and win up to \$10,000 more on non-jackpot prizes.
