LAREDO RESIDENT CLAIMS \$1 MILLION SCRATCH TICKET PRIZE

AUSTIN – A Laredo resident claimed a top prize winning ticket worth \$1 million in the Texas Lottery[®] scratch ticket game Millions Club. The ticket was purchased at H-E-B Food Store #449, located at 7811 McPherson Ave., in Laredo. The claimant elected to remain anonymous.

This was the third of 10 top prizes worth \$1 million to be claimed in this game. Millions Club offers more than \$161 million in total prizes. Overall odds of winning any prize in the game are one in 3.36, including break-even prizes.
