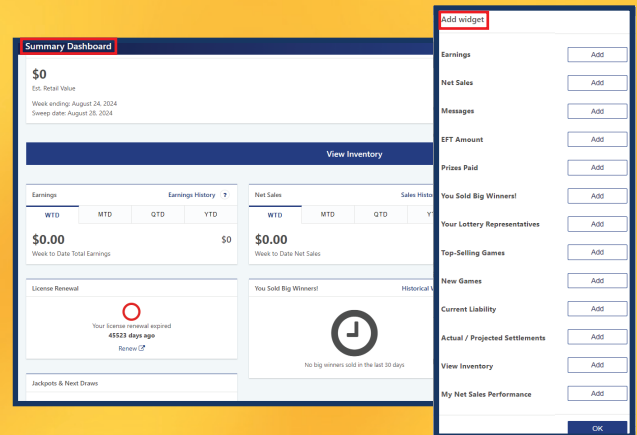

RETAILER RULES

WHAT ABOUT SPLIT TENDER?

Split tender means using more than one form of payment for a transaction.

Split tender is allowed for a transaction including lottery and non-lottery products, but it must follow strict payment rules.

Lottery products must always be paid for with approved lottery payment methods: **cash, debit card, check and Texas Lottery-issued coupons and vouchers.**

Non-lottery products may be paid for with lottery approved or other methods like credit cards, gift cards and EBT. A customer may combine payment types, but the retailer's system or cashier must ensure that no un-approved tender is used for lottery purchase.
