RCIP ON HOLD UNTIL 2025

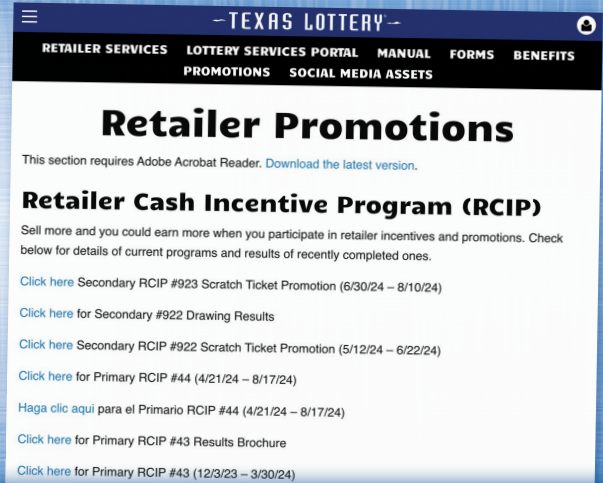

CONSUMER PROTECTION

Lottery is Only for Customers 18 and Older



Retailers are NOT AUTHORIZED to:

- Sell lottery tickets to a minor (person under 18 years of age).
- Pay prizes claimed by a minor.
- Pay prizes to an adult presenting a prize-winning ticket on behalf of a minor. The adult should contact the Texas Lottery at 800-375-6886 for claim instructions.

RETAILER RULES



YOU ARE IMPORTANT TO US! Avoid Texas Lottery® Retailer Violations

Here are two common violations to avoid:

- 1) Licensee may not intentionally or knowingly sell a ticket by extending credit or lending money to enable a person to buy a ticket.
- 2) Licensee may not intentionally or knowingly sell a ticket and accept anything for payment not specifically allowed under the State Lottery Act.
 - ONLY the following forms of payment are acceptable for lottery purchases: cash, debit card, check and Texas Lottery issued coupons and vouchers.
 - Credit cards are NEVER acceptable for lottery purchases.
 - Retailers may not require a minimum purchase for lottery purchases with a debit card.
 - Retailers may not give a ticket to a player who says they will pay later or run a tab for a customer to play and then pay later.
 - Penalties range from **License Suspension** to **License Revocation**.
