

AMENDMENT NO. 7

to the

CONTRACT FOR LOTTERY OPERATIONS AND SERVICES

between the

TEXAS LOTTERY COMMISSION

and

IGT GLOBAL SOLUTIONS CORPORATION

WHEREAS, the Texas Lottery Commission (the "Commission" or "Texas Lottery") and IGT Global Solutions Corporation, with an assumed name in the State of Texas of "IGT Solutions Corporation" (formerly known as GTECH Corporation) ("IGT") (collectively, "the Parties") entered into a contract for Lottery Operations and Services with an effective date of December 14, 2010, as amended by Amendment No. 1 effective August 10, 2011, Amendment No. 2 effective January 30, 2012, Amendment No. 3 effective September 19, 2012, Amendment No. 4 effective March 8, 2013, Amendment No. 5 effective April 4, 2013, and Amendment No. 6 effective October 23, 2014 (collectively, the "Contract");

WHEREAS, Section 3.4 of the Contract states the Contract may be amended only by a written agreement signed by both Parties, and in accordance with Tex. Gov't Code Ann. §466.1005(b), only written agreements approved by the Commission and signed by the Executive Director of the Texas Lottery shall be binding on the Texas Lottery, and only written agreements signed by an officer of IGT Global Solutions shall be binding on IGT; and

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to amend the Contract as more specifically set forth below.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to Section 3.4 of the Contract, and for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Parties agree to amend the Contract as follows:

- 1. **Name Change**. All references in the Contract to "GTECH Corporation" or "GTECH" are hereby amended to "IGT Global Solutions Corporation, with an assumed name in the State of Texas of IGT Solutions Corporation" or "IGT", as applicable.
- 2. Jackpot Backer Signs. The following sections of the RFP shall be deleted in their entirety from the Contract and are no longer required to be delivered by IGT under the Contract: (a) Section 6.3 (Service Level Monitoring and Reporting), Table 6 (Service Level Monitoring and Reporting Requirements), Detail Requirement no. 5, and Table 7 (Service Level Monitoring and Reporting Response Requirements), Response Requirement no. 5 and (b) IGT's associated responses to these RFP sections in IGT's

Proposal. In exchange for the Texas Lottery agreeing to delete the above-referenced sections from the RFP and IGT's Proposal (as incorporated into the Contract) and thereby waive IGT's related obligations, IGT, at no additional expense to the Texas Lottery, shall instead be responsible for, on a yearly basis, the production, supply and replacement (i.e., installation) of all Texas Lottery retailer jackpot backer signs (the "Jackpot Backer Signs"). IGT shall order and have produced the Jackpot Backer Signs upon receipt of approved designs from the Texas Lottery. Once received, IGT shall install the Jackpot Backer Signs in accordance with a Texas Lottery and IGT mutually agreed-to delivery and installation schedule. Jackpot Backer Signs are considered non-sales lottery equipment and subject to sanction requirements 3.60.44 and 3.60.45 on Attachment 1 – Sanction Schedule of the Contract.

3. In connection with and pursuant to Amendment No. 6, Section 1.D. of the Contract, IGT has offered and the Commission has agreed to accept (A) a new call center knowledge management tool (GNIE) system ("GNIE System") and (B) a new instant ticket conveyer system ("Instant Ticket Conveyor System"), as such systems are described below. IGT shall be responsible for the respective costs associated with these systems (as set forth below).

A. GNIE System - Requirements.

- (1) IGT shall provide its proprietary GNIE System, including but not limited to all required software to create, organize and edit articles and graphics, as well as the menu, search and drill-down capabilities. This GNIE System is to be implemented as a standalone system and provide the Texas Lottery with the same functionality that is used in IGT's call centers.
- (2) IGT shall be responsible for all costs associated with the procurement, implementation, hosting, maintenance, licenses, and ongoing software support of the GNIE System.
- (3) IGT shall provide a project manager to lead product implementation and training for one year from the execution date of this Amendment No. 7. IGT shall work with the Texas Lottery to develop an implementation plan and timeline, which must be approved in writing by the Texas Lottery before IGT begins work on installing the GNIE System.

B. Instant Ticket Conveyor System - Requirements.

(1) IGT shall provide the Instant Ticket Conveyor System to be built to identical physical specifications as the existing conveyor currently used in IGT's Texas warehouse. The Instant Ticket Conveyor System shall include customized software and have the ability to scan barcodes and sort up to five different bins.

- (2) IGT shall be responsible for all costs associated with the procurement, implementation, maintenance, licenses, and ongoing software support of the Instant Ticket Conveyor System.
- (3) IGT shall work with the Texas Lottery to develop an implementation plan and timeline, which must be approved in writing by the Texas Lottery before IGT begins work on installing the Instant Ticket Conveyor System.
- C. The Contract is amended to include the following sanction regarding performance of the GNIE System and Instant Ticket Conveyor System.

3.60.73 Failure to Resolve an Instant Ticket Conveyor System or GNIE System Problem. The failure of IGT to resolve an Instant Ticket Conveyor System or GNIE System problem and return the respective system to service within two (2) Working Days of IGT's notification of such problem, may result in IGT being assessed sanctions.

3. Section 6.5, Table 16, Compliance Review Service Levels, Service Level Requirement 3.60.17 is deleted and replaced with the following:

- 4. Section 7.5, Table 39, Retailer Management Requirements, Detail Requirement no. 26 is deleted and replaced with the following:
 - 26. The Successful ProposerIGT must upload the debit, credit and new Retailer files received from ICS into the Successful Proposer's System within four (4) hours after receipt from the Texas Lottery. the Texas Lottery into IGT's Lottery Gaming System by the date and time specified in the Data Exchange Report.
- 5. Section 7.6.3, Table 46, Sales and Marketing System General Requirements, Detail Requirement no. 9 as added by Amendment No. 5 -- is changed to read Detail Requirement no. 10.
- 6. Section 7.7, Table 51, System Management Service Levels, Service Level Requirement 3.60.34 is deleted and replaced with the following:

7. Section 7.10, Table 58, ICS System and Vendor Requirements, Detail Requirement no. 10 is deleted and replaced with the following:

- 10. The Successful ProposerIGT shall load debit, credit and/or new Retailer files received from the Texas Lottery into the Lottery Gaming System within four (4) hours after receipt of the files by the date and time specified in the Data Exchange Report.
- 8. Section 8.5, Table 92, Retailer Contests and Retailer-based Player Promotions Requirements, Detail Requirement no. 19 is deleted and replaced with the following:
 - 19. The Successful ProposerIGT must deliver the list of winning Retailer(s) within five (5) Working Days of the conclusion of the contest. Upon approval of the list by the Texas Lottery, the Successful ProposerIGT must deliver the prizes to the winning Retailer(s) within thirty (30) Working Days and provide signed receipts from the winning Retailers(s) to the Texas Lottery within forty-five (45) Working Days of approval of the list.
- 9. Section 8.6, Table 94, Promotional Events and Retailer Promotions Requirements, Detail Requirement no. 25 is deleted and replaced with the following:
 - 25. The Successful ProposerIGT must recommend promotional events and Retailer promotions in an annual plan submitted to the Texas Lottery by April 30no later than March 31 of each year. The Promotion Plan must include recommendations for Lottery Product kick-off events, annual promotional events (e.g., State Fair of Texas, South by Southwest Music and Film Festival, etc.). The Plan must be robust and detailed and contain a package of suggested promotional events and programs that take into account the full scope of the Texas Lottery's advertising and marketing efforts in creating a complete package of support for Lottery Products across the State. The Plan must contain projected staffing requirements, promotional item and ticket quantity projections distribution, point-of-sale signage needs and related equipment plans.
- 10. Section 8.7, Table 99, Marketing Material and Related Equipment Service Levels, is deleted and replaced with the following:

11. Section 9.3.1, Table 108, Warehouse Instant Ticket Return Verification Requirements, Detail Requirement no. 9 is deleted and replaced with the following:

- 9. All manual (damaged, defective, etc.) full or partial pack ticket returns must be returned to the central distribution warehouse and processed for credit to the Retailer's account within twenty-one (21) Days from Retailer pickup.
- 12. Attachment 1 Sanctions Schedule and Attachment 2 Liquidated Damages Schedule of the Contract are deleted and replaced in their entirety with the Sanctions and Liquidated Damages Schedules attached to this Amendment No. 7 as Exhibit A. The attachments included in Exhibit A are incorporated into and expressly made a part of the Contract for all purposes. The following sanctions and liquidated damages are amended/added/deleted:

- 13. Except as amended hereby, all of the terms of the Contract remain in full force and effect. All capitalized terms not specifically defined herein shall have the meaning assigned to such terms in the Contract.
- 14. This Amendment shall be effective upon execution by both Parties.
