Frequently Asked Questions: How can players pay for tickets?

Credit cards are never accepted for Texas Lottery purchases.

The only authorized and acceptable forms of payment for Texas Lottery purchases are:

- cash
- checks
- debit cards
- Texas Lottery issued coupons and vouchers.

Retailers may choose which authorized forms(s) of payment to accept.

The following list includes some forms of payment that are **not acceptable**. The list only provides examples and is not comprehensive.

- credit cards
- gift cards
- food stamp benefits(EBT, Lone Star Card)
- 8-liner coupons

Retailers may **not**:

- require a minimum purchase for lottery purchases with a debit card.
- extend credit or lend money to buy a ticket or give a ticket to a person who says they will pay later.
